We completed a £2.5 million refurbishment of our bedrooms in 2021.

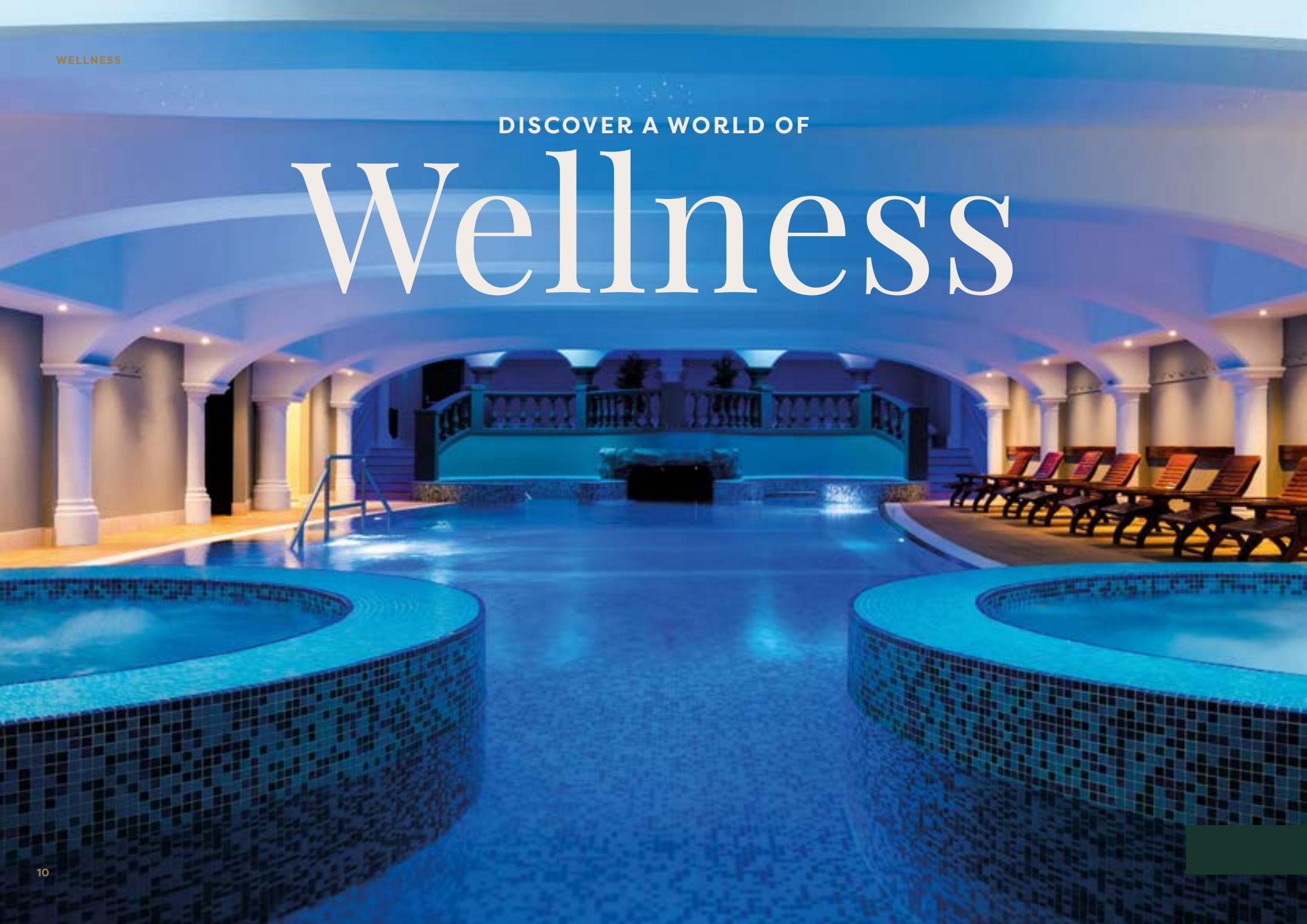
Our 104 bedrooms are as individual as our guests, and as well-honed hosts, we think they are all rather stylish and sophisticated and each has a different outlook!

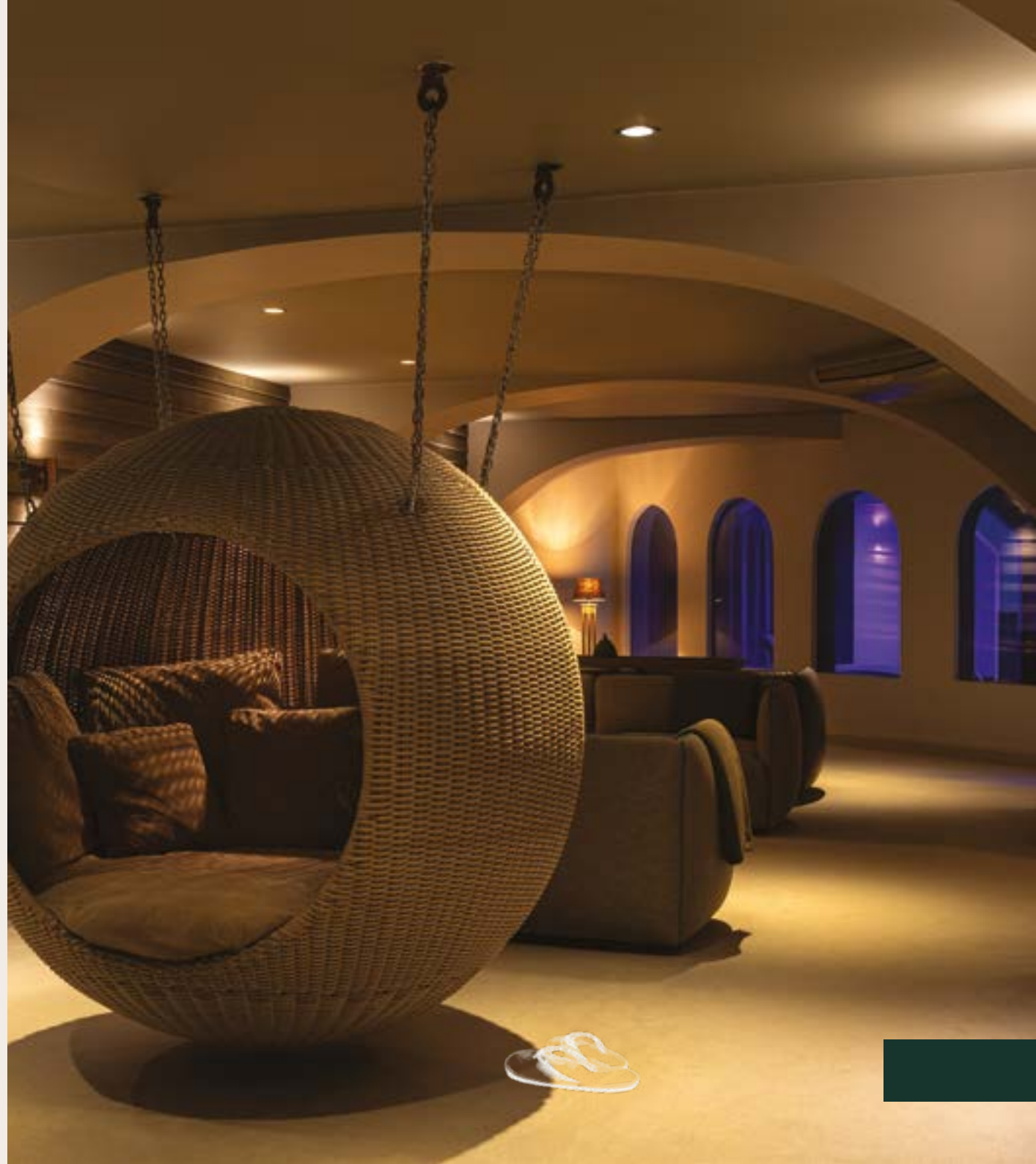

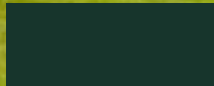
